NINTH JOINT STATUS REPORT & [PROPOSED] ORDER

Pursuant to this Court's Order dated June 8, 2023, the parties submit this ninth Joint Status Report to update the Court on the status of the litigation and their proposed next steps. Order, ECF No. 42.

Background

Plaintiffs brought this action under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552 *et seq*. They seek nine categories of records related to Defendant U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement's ("ICE") use of BI, Incorporated's SmartLINK App as part of its Intensive Supervision and Appearance Program ("ISAP"). Plaintiffs filed this lawsuit against ICE and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (collectively, "Defendants") on April 14, 2022. ECF No. 1. Defendants filed an Answer on May 23, 2022. ECF No. 10.

Status of Litigation

As of January 2023, ICE had completed production of responsive records. Fourth Joint Status Report, ECF No. 31. Plaintiffs have indicated the subset of records for which they plan to challenge withholdings of information, as well as the exemptions at issue. Fifth Joint Status Report, ECF No. 34. In March and May 2023, Plaintiffs sought additional information from Defendants to help Plaintiffs determine the adequacy of Defendants' search for responsive Ninth Joint Status Report

1	records. On July 26, Defendants agreed to provide a response to Plaintiffs' questions in 30 days
2	The information is necessary to help Plaintiffs determine whether to challenge the adequacy of
3	Defendants' search.

5	The parties propose that this Court vacate the August 3, 2023, Case Management
6	Conference and order the parties to submit another joint status report on September 7, 2023,
7	identifying what, if anything, is left to litigate.
